- Become a fully qualified healthcare professional immediately after graduation, giving you access to attractive salaries and high employability after just five years of study.


A career that enables you to work for the benefit of others...

- Specialist training and strategically targeted work placements ensure that RCSI Pharmacy Graduates are ready for the workplace immediately after graduation
- Graduates have an internationally portable qualification and can register as pharmacists in Ireland and throughout the European Union immediately after graduation. The MPharm, and the integrated internship, is also recognised by the Malaysian Pharmacy Board (MPB), allowing its graduates to register to practice in Malaysia (upon passing the licensing exam) without the need for an additional internship in Malaysia.
- The MPharm will also act as a platform for professional pharmacy registration in other geographies.

The MPharm degree is accredited by the National University of Ireland (NUI) and the Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland (PSI). Graduates of the MPharm are therefore eligible to register as pharmacists in Ireland and throughout the European Union (EU) directly after graduation. The MPharm qualification also acts as a platform for professional registration as a practising pharmacist in other geographies throughout the world.

RCSI offers its students a unique learning environment in which to study, where they become part of a large international student community, studying an academically rigorous programme in the only specialist health sciences university in Ireland.
